FORGOTTEN VOYAGES - REDISCOVERING THE S.S. GEORGETTE

On Thursday 30th of November 1876, the S.S. Georgette left Busselton bound for Adelaide via Albany, carrying cargo and passengers. The steamship sadly didn't make her destination in a tragic loss of life that echoed around the globe. The Busselton Courthouse hosted the initial inquiry into the tragedy and we are proud to present this award-winning exhibition that shares previously untold stories, honours the heroes and commemorates those who perished at sea.

ROLE PLAY RE-ENACTMENT OF THE INITIAL INQUIRY INTO THE WRECK OF THE S.S. GEORGETTE

Dressed in costumes, students are selected by their teacher to play roles of the accused, heroes and witnesses. A staff member will lead the re-enactment of the inquiry. The student gallery will then judge the outcome before the true verdict is revealed.
